This is a playing day for instrumentalists and singers who enjoy playing or singing one-to-a-part. The emphasis will be on small ensembles but there may be some opportunity to double (eg as a singer) in the final session.

In the first two sessions participants will be divided into groups to explore Venetian consort music of the 16th century. The organisers will bring a range of music for different ensembles but participants are also encouraged to bring their own. Emma Murphy will divide her time between the groups to provide encouraging and supportive tutoring. In the final session Emma will direct a single polychoral work.

Applications are welcome from singers and from players of any instruments of the 16th century, including violins, viols, recorders, flutes, sackbuts, cornetts, harps, and double reeds. Pitch is A=440. Non-members are very welcome.

Venue: The Music Block, Simon Langton Girls' Grammar School, Old Dover Road, Canterbury, Kent CT1 3EW. Canterbury East Station 1.2 miles, Canterbury West Station 1.8 miles. There is ample parking at the school.

Fee: £12 for members of SEMF or other Early Music Fora, £16 for non-members. Under 25s £5. SEMF membership AND workshop £20 (full membership costs £8.50).
