The music for this workshop will include both instrumental canzonas by Giovanni Gabrieli and 8 part Vespers by Chiara Margarita Cozzolani, a nun at Santa Radegonda in Milan, which was well known for the quality of its music. The exact repertoire will depend on the forces available.

Open to the following instruments:

Cornetts, sackbuts, curtals/dulcians, recorders, viol and violin family, plucked continuo. *Violin family players do not need to have a baroque instrument.*

Copies of parts will be available on the day. Please bring a stand.

Pitch is A=440.

Fee: £14.00 for members of SEMF and other Fora, £20.00 for non-members and £8.00 for under 25s.

Acceptance will be subject to musical balance.

Late applications after 25 January (if accepted) attract a £2 surcharge. We regret that after this date it will not be possible to return fees for cancellations.

Emily White is professor of sackbut at The Guildhall School of Music and Drama and also teaches trombone and sackbut at The Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama. Emily is a member of The English Cornett & Sackbut Ensemble (ECSE), who play internationally and are especially known for their collaborations with vocal ensembles such as I Fagiolini.

Venue: Smarden Charter Hall, Chessenden Lane, Smarden, Kent TN27 8NF. There is car parking on site. Headcorn railway station is three miles away, and it may be possible to arrange lifts from the station.
