The range of instruments typically includes recorders, flutes, oboes, bassoons, curtals, sackbuts, violins, cellos, viols, rebecs. We welcome keyboard players, especially if they can bring a keyboard (electronic ones included). The programme will depend upon the mix of voices and instruments. A range of music for instrumental, vocal, & mixed ensembles will be available but participants can also bring music they would like to perform. We play at A440 except by special arrangement. Good sight-reading and intonation is needed. Please bring a music stand.


Arrive for coffee at 10.30; first session starts at 11.00. Tea and coffee will be provided but not lunch.
