A range of music for instrumental, vocal, & mixed ensembles will be available but participants can also bring music they would like to perform.

We play at A440 except by special arrangement.
Good sight-reading and intonation is needed.
Please bring a music stand.

Timetable: coffee/tuning at 10.30am. Music begins at 11am & ends at 5.00pm with breaks for lunch & tea. Coffee & tea provided. Bring your own lunch (no pubs or cafés nearby).
