Orlando Gibbons and the music of Westminster Abbey

An online talk by Patrick Craig


Tuesday 27th January 2026, 7.30 - 8.30 pm on Zoom



Orlando Gibbons was one of the most brilliant and imaginative composers this country has ever produced. He is beloved by jazz musicians such as Glenn Gould for his inventive and unpredictable genius. In this lecture Patrick traces his career at Westminster Abbey, looking at his predecessors who shaped his education, and looking ahead to some of the great musicians who followed him there including Pelham Humfrey, Henry Purcell and his own son Christopher Gibbons.

Patrick Craig is well known to Members of Early Music Fora for his expert and enthusiastic direction of workshops.

He is a countertenor who sang a thousand concerts with The Tallis Scholars while also singing as a Vicar Choral at St Paul's Cathedral, where he has worked for almost thirty years. He has also recorded extensively as a member of The Cardinall's Musick. He lectures on choral music for the Arts Society and conducts singing workshops for organisations across Europe. In addition, he is the founder Director of this country's preeminent all-female professional choir Aurora Nova.
